### **Live Audition Requirements**

- \$30 audition fee
- Headshot (4 x 6 preferred)
- Letter of Intent describing your artistic goals
- Resume of Training
- Completed Registration Form

Registration begins 30 minutes before the listed audition time. Pre-registration is strongly recommended.

Mail completed form with the audition requirements to America's Ballet School.

Only completed packets postmarked 2 weeks before the audition you are attending will be accepted.

### **Video Audition Requirements**

- \$30 audition fee
- Headshot (4 x 6 preferred)
- Letter of Intent describing your artistic goals
- Resume of Training
- Completed Audition Registration Form

The video should include a sample of barre work, a center adagio, a grand allegro, pointe work (if applicable){class work or classical variation}, and a solo or your choice. The solo should highlight your artistry and movement quality. The solo can be in any style that you prefer, your own choreography or someone else's.

The main focus of your video should be your solo work and your center work.

Tapes should be no longer than 10 minutes in length.

Preferred format is regular-sized DVDs, but VHS tapes will be accepted.

Video auditions must be postmarked by April 20, 2011

The results of your audition will be emailed to you within two weeks of your audition.

***The non-refundable deposit of 50% of your total tuition and housing will be due by June 1<sup>st</sup>. The remainder of the tuition and housing will be due on July 1<sup>st</sup>.***
